

The fall Board of Directors meeting of SFS was held at Hunter on Sept 10, 2019 at 6:30 pm.

Brock called the meeting to order with Brock, Brent, Eden, and Renee answering roll call. Rusty was absent from the meeting.

It was reported that we are in good standing with the Secretary of State and the IRS.

Activities throughout 2019 so far include, 1 organizational meeting, 8 membership meetings and 2 Board of Director meetings (organizational and annual).

Two snowmobile fun runs were participated in. 1 SFS run from Ryder, and 1 Road Angels" Brave the Shave" benefit at Hitching Post in Benedict.

Members participated in "Loping for Leland" Horse Trail ride benefit in Ryder.

Brent ran the trail system twice for probable routes. Brent and Sylvan ran the trail on 6 occasions for signing count.

Brent, Sylvan and Steve ran the route with SND Director and Groomer Operator Dale Diebert for signage and crossing utilization.

SFS has held one cash raffle.

The accomplishments of the SFS snowmobile club include: Started up Sakakawea Fence Stretchers Snowmobile Club that has 28 memberships and 51 members. We have drafted a Banking Resolution and Approved a Corporate Seal. We have successfully filed and amended ND "Articles of Incorporation." We have obtained an IRS Federal Employee ID. Rusty and Brent meet with Ward and Mclean County Commissioners and obtained approval for trails. We obtained 501 (c) (3) federal income tax exemptions from IRS. We secured 150 miles of groomed trail funding from SND.

In new business, the treasurer is to file IRS Form 990 for the 2019 fiscal year by Feb, 15, 2020 with the IRS. The secretary is to file the Annual Report for 2019 with the Secretary of State by Jan 3, 2020.

Eden gave a financial report but no current numbers were available as the raffle income and winnings have not been taken care of since the drawing is to be held after this meeting.

With no other business, Brent made a motion to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Eden.
